



Payment Agreement Contract+

By this contract, I agree to make payments to East West Integrative Medicine for all outstanding balances. I agree that East-West Integrative Medicine will charge my valid, working credit/debit card a regular monthly payment of a minimum of 10% of all outstanding balances until the total has been completely repaid.

This agreement is binding, and failure to meet its terms will allow East West Integrative Medicine to take appropriate recourse, including, but not limited to, legal recourse, refusal of service, reporting to a collection agency and more. I agree it is my responsibility to ensure that the credit or debit card on file will not have any issues with my obligations to East-West and that East-West will not contact me if issues arise. If for any reason any scheduled repayment is late (the credit/debit card has insufficient funds, has expired, etc.), a \$5 per day late charge will ensue until the entire amount of the scheduled repayment, with additional late fees, is paid.

By signing this agreement, I agree to the terms as described above. Alterations to this agreement can only be made by both parties and must be placed in writing with appropriate signatures. Both parties will receive a printed copy of this agreement, and will be responsible for upholding its terms.

\* Depending on where that date falls during the workweek and holidays, East-West can charge the card on the date above or any time up to five (5) days after the date above. East-West will not charge the card on file before that date.
